

Will of John Filby of Thuxton 1766 Ref ANF W105 f272 (MF230)

(105) In the name of God Amen. I John Filby of
THUXTON in the County of Northfolk Farmer being of sound and disposing
 mind and memory (praised be Almighty God) Do revoke all my former
 wills and Testaments and make and ordain this to be my last will
 and Testament First I give and devise all my cheif tenures and
 Tenements and Hereditaments whatsoever situate lying and being
GARVESTON in the said County and elsewhere unto ⁽¹⁾ Juller Filby my
son and his heirs. Also I give and bequeath unto ⁽²⁾ Richard Filby
my son Twenty shillings if he shall be living at my decease and
 personally demand the same of my Executor. Also I give and
 bequeath unto ⁽³⁾ my Grandson John Filby son of my said son Juller
Filby the sum of one hundred Pounds of good and lawfull money
 of Great Brittain to be paid by my Executor within Twelve or
 Calendar monthes after my decease if he the said John shall be the
 living. Also I give and bequeath unto ⁽⁴⁾ my Grand daughter Ann
Filby Daughter of my son John lately deceased the sum of
Fifty pounds of like lawfull money to be paid to her within two
 Calendar monthes after my decease if she shall be then living
 Also I give unto my ⁽⁵⁾ Grand daughter Mary the wife of James
WILSON the sum of Ten Pounds of like lawfull money to be paid
 her within Twelve Calendar monthes after my decease if she shall
 be then living. Also I give unto my ⁽⁶⁾ Grandson Richard son
my said son Richard the sum of five pounds to be paid to my said
 Grandson Richard within Twelve Calendar monthes after my decease

if he shall be then living & the Legacies in the Will whom I was
with me Five pounds to be paid to her within three months after my decease

Legacies shall die before his her or their respective legacies or
