David Phelby of the Parish of St Mary located in the County of Surrey. Hereby being too weak in the body but sound in mind after renouncing my soul into the hands of () that gave it my Will and pleasure is that my Body be soundly interred and (?) that my just debts be equally paid out. Firstly that my loving wife Elizabeth Philby be left my whole and sole Executus together with all my efforts of any kind whatsoever and to carry out the Business of the (house?) for the profit and support of herself and family unless at any time thereafter let the house (?) it were for the good of the whole to quit the said Business and go into any other way and this I swear to be my last Will and Testament this 15th May 1785 signed and sealed in the pleasure of David Filby Witness (Wm Summerland and Wm Reed) 14th June 1785
